The Community First Responders from Miltown Malbay / Moy Defibrillator Group are now fully trained and certified to meet National Ambulance Service standards in responding to emergency call outs.

They have linked with the National Ambulance Service since January 19th. This means that when a 999 or 112 call for heart attack, chest pain, stroke or choking is received by the Ambulance Service from anyone in Miltown Malbay and Moy parish, the Defibrillator Group will also receive a text and will be in a position to respond in a timely manner.

They would like to thank Tony Cogan for organising the Christmas Day Swim at White Strand and the local community who supported both the swim and the recent Church Gate Collection which have helped to pay for two new defibrillators, one in Miltown and one in Moy, new cabinets, training equipment and other resources.
