"There is room for everyone in the Church – whenever there is not please, we must make room, including for those who make mistakes, who fail or struggle. The Church has to be the home where the Echo of God's call to everyone resounds. The Lord does not close the door – but invites us to enter. He does not keep us distant. He welcomes us. Let us call each by name – God loves you all God Loves you

Do not keep your questions to yourself. Bring your questions to Jesus In the dialogue of Prayer God catches us off guard. God responds. He is not a search engine God is your true friend. God asks you questions too.

The Apostles were asking questions and waiting for answers from Jesus. He took them by surprise – he sent them on a mission – without proper preparation – no bag or purse He puts the same trust in you. The Disciples returned from their Mission with Joy. He just needs a small response on your part to fill our lives with wonder and joy you might say "I can't do that.
