# SEAFIELD SAND DUNES BIODIVERSITY PLAN

Seafield Conservation Forum has received funding support from Community Finance Ireland to develop the first Community Biodiversity Action Plan for Seafield sand dunes. Developed by an expert ecologist, the plan will provide a blueprint of actions to guide sand dune restoration and conservation work over the next five years. Developing the plan is also an essential first step in fostering national stakeholder support and recognition for climate adaptation measures for Seafield. Addressing coastal erosion is essential, particularly given the pattern of coastal flooding projected to impact Seafield and the wider Kilmurry Ibrickane shoreline in the coming years. Once complete, Seafield Conservation Forum will share the contents of the Biodiversity Plan online.
