ÉIGSE THOMÁIS UÍ AODHA, 2024: The 6th annual Irish-language festival, organised by Oidhreacht an Chláir in memory of Miltown man Tomás Ó hAodha (1866-1935), teacher, poet, dramatist, novelist, actor, choirmaster, cartographer and Gaeilge activist, will be held on October 11-12 in Áras OaC (Flag Road). On Friday 11th at 8.00pm, renowned broadcaster Seán Bán Breathnach will give a talk, *53 bliain ag craoladh: Cumann Lúthchleas Gael mar a bhí agus mar atá*, in which he will speak on his remarkable 53-year career as a broadcaster with RTÉ Raidió na Gaeltachta and TG4 and share his thoughts on how the GAA has changed over the years. There will also be an exhibition of the personal Archive (Carlann) of Tomás Ó hAodha, donated by his family to Oidhreacht an Chláir. On Saturday 12th, 10.30-12.00 noon, beidh *Ceardlann Amhránaíochta* (Singing Workshop) le Éamon Ó Donnchadha, three-time winner of Corn Uí Riada, followed by a visit to the home of Tomás i mBóthar na hInse. Ó 3.00pm to 5.30pm, beidh *Ceol agus Caint* i Friel's, featuring a Pop-Up Gaeltacht as an opportunity for people to use their Irish in an informal and friendly environment, amhráin le Éamon Ó Donnchadha agus Tim Dennehy, agus ceol le Joan Hanrahan (fíidil) and Bríd O'Gorman (fliúit).
