THE OLD KILFARBOY SOCIETY:

The December talk of the Old Kilfarboy Society will take place on Tuesday, 10th December, in the Malbay, Miltown Malbay at 8pm. Ben Taylor, professional photographer, will talk about incidents and coincidences that occurred while producing some of the images in a 2016 book written by Howard Marshall. The book, *Out of Darkness, the Blind Piper of Inagh*, is a 400 page tome on the life and times of Garrett Barry, 1847-1899. Though born at a time of extreme deprivation and with his physical handicap, he achieved a high status within his cultural sphere. His piping skills and commitment to his community earned him the title "father of Gaelic music" in his native place. He was an inspiration to a generation of pipers and musicians, many of whom have become legends in their own right, like Johnny Doran and Willie Clancy.
