Launch of Miltown Malbay QR Code Heritage Trail **-A Vision for Sustainable Digital Heritage**

Miltown Malbay Community Enhancement Clg would like to extend an open invitation to the people of Miltown Malbay and the environs to join us in the heart of Miltown Malbay for the official launch of the Miltown Malbay Heritage Trail, a unique and accessible digital journey through the town's rich cultural, historical, and social heritage.

The launch takes place at the Miltown Malbay Community Centre with the overview of the project by the MMCEClg. This will be followed by an introduction to the trail by historian and developer Dr. John Treacy, who will present the story behind the creation of this innovative trail. Learn how the 22-points of interest walking route combines traditional storytelling with modern technology via QR codes, Braille, and captioned audio guides, making heritage accessible to all.
