ÉIGSE THOMÁIS UÍ AODHA, 2025: The 7th annual Irish-language festival, organised by Oidhreacht an Chláir in memory of Miltown man Tomás Ó hAodha (1866-1935), teacher, poet, dramatist, novelist, actor, choirmaster, cartographer and Gaeilge activist, will be held on October 10-11 in Áras OaC (Flag Road). On Friday 10th at 8.00pm, the Éigse lecture, *An Stát agus an Ghaeilge*, will be delivered by Ciarán Ó Feinneadha, a major figure in the Irish Language movement for over 50 years. He will speak of the many fraught years he has spent in endeavouring to ensure that Irish-speakers can enjoy their rights throughout the State system. There will also be an exhibition of the personal Archive (Cartlann) of Tomás Ó hAodha, donated by his family to Oidhreacht an Chláir. On Saturday 12th, 10.30-12.00 noon, beidh *Ceardlann Amhránaíochta* (Singing Workshop) le Éamonn Ó Bróithe, a noted singer and authority on Munster traditional singing, followed by a visit to the home of Tomás i mBóthar na hInse. Ó 3.00pm to 5.30pm, beidh *Ceol agus Caint* i Friel's, featuring a Pop-Up Gaeltacht as an opportunity for people to use their Irish in an informal and friendly environment, amhráin le Éamonn Ó Bróithe agus Tim Dennehy, agus ceol le Pádraic Keane (píob uilleann) agus Cillian Boyd (fliúit). Gabhaimid buíochas le Foras na Gaeilge agus le Comhairle Contae an Chláir as a dtacaíocht. All events are free. Míle fáilte roimh chách.
