THE DEVIL'S IN THE DANCE HALL

Saturday 22nd November in Mullagh Community Hall Co. Clare was a hotspot for prosecutions under the 1935 Dance Halls Act.

A widow in Cooraclare was summoned after a sergeant passing her home at 1:30 in the morning noticed many bicycles outside and heard music. Around thirty people were inside in the kitchen; some had travelled considerable distances, as far as Kilmihil, about twelve miles away. They were flat out dancing a set with reels bursting from a flute player in the corner.

The widow had hosted dances at her house both before and after the Act came in. She did not take money on the door, she said she had no need, but ran the dances for neighbours who helped with her farm. The judge remarked with some astonishment:

... this lady, whose dancing days in the natural order of things should be over, had organised a dance and invited people there. She was not very flush in the world's goods; still she could bring people there and have a dance in her house. He could not see what amusement she got from watching people dance up to 2am when she should be in her bed.

So it's only right that we bring The Devil's in the Dance Hall to west Clare!

Come join us in Mullagh Hall, 22nd November, where we'll step back to the 1930s and dance the night away to the roaring sounds of the Gralton Big Band. Expect set dancing, sean nós, shim shamming and scandal!
